## **Transfer to Junior School - September 2021**

We would like to invite parents of Year 2 children attending Buryfields to visit Mayhill to find out more about us and have a look around the school. This is not as easy as in previous years!

When choosing a school, there are a number of factors parents will consider such as locality, friends, wrap around care provision, inspection reports etc. However, I believe the most important factor is the feeling you get when you walk in as each school has its own ethos. We are very proud of the way Mayhill continues to flourish and feel it is important to find a way to share this with you – as safely as we can.

This year we will not be offering a presentation or tours led by the children, but we can offer you a tour with the Head Teacher or senior member of staff in groups of no more than two families at a time. In addition, there is a page on our website, available [here](#), which has been set up specifically for families whose child may transition to Mayhill next year. It has videos and other information on it from earlier this year as well as a presentation from myself with key information on it for admissions next year. We would recommend looking at this webpage before booking a tour.

Currently there are 68 children in Year 2, so to avoid leading 34 tours, please can I request that families who already have a sibling at Mayhill and know they will be sending their child here, to consider whether this is really necessary. Ideally, please watch the presentation and we will offer tours to see the school in 2021.

Please note, that currently the government advice is that adults should wear a face covering in indoor places where social distancing may be difficult and where you will come into contact with people you do not normally meet. Consequently, parents will be asked to wear masks or a visor when inside the building. It may be later in the year we are able to relax this.

I hope that you will select Mayhill as the school for your child, and look forward to working with you in the future.
