The children will be focusing their learning around the Victorian era, as Odiham Grammar School was built and opened in 1880, here on this site. The main building of Mayhill is dated to this time.


The children will also look at the architecture of the changing school site and buildings, comparing these to how our school looks now.

What to wear

Girls - dark dresses/skirts and tops and *if possible*, something that looks like the white pinafores Victorian girls wore over their clothes.

Boys, dark shorts (grey flannel school shorts are ideal) with dark jackets or jumpers and white shirts.



The children could complete additional research in preparation of this day, maybe someone significant from the Victorian period or an event of this time period. (1837-1901).

They may decide how they present this research so that it can be shared with their class, some will be chosen to be displayed within the school.
